AUBMC was the first medical institution in the Middle East to have earned the four international accreditations to:

AUBMC was the first hospital located outside the United States to be accredited in 1956 by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Hospitals. The hospital was repeatedly surveyed since and maintained its accreditation till 1986. During war time the JCI surveyor team refrained from coming to Lebanon but when they resumed their surveys AUBMC was reaccredited again in 2007 and has been reaccredited every three years since.	AUBMC was the only medical institution in the Middle East and the first in Lebanon to get Magnet® accredited in 2009. The Magnet Recognition Program by the American Nurses Credentialing Center recognizes healthcare organizations for providing excellence in nursing.	The College of American Pathologists (CAP) is the worldwide leader in laboratory quality assurance, providing laboratories guidelines for high-quality and cost-effective patient care. In Lebanon, AUBMC is the only CAP accredited institution.	AUBMC became the first medical center in Lebanon and the fourth in the world to receive institutional accreditation from the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education – International (ACGME-I). The accreditation became effective as of July 2014. AUBMC was also granted accreditation of specific residency programs effective July 2015 in four programs: Internal Medicine, Family Medicine, Emergency Medicine, Obstetrics and Gynecology. The accreditations were granted based on two aspects: foundational and advanced Specialty.

AUBMC is now home to four clinical Centers of Excellence:

- The Abu-Haidar Neuroscience Institute (AHNI), which is dedicated to clinical and basic neurosciences.
- The Children's Cancer Center of Lebanon, which is affiliated with St. Jude Children's Research Hospital in Memphis, Tennessee, and serves as a referral center for Lebanon and the region for pediatric cancer.
- The Naef K. Basile Cancer Center, which is dedicated to the treatment of adult cancers.
- The Multiple Sclerosis (MS) Center, the first MS Center in the Middle East.

These Centers of Excellence have strong, clinical, educational and research programs in diseases specific to the region.

- First medical institution to perform an endobronchial ultrasound (EBUS)-guided needle aspiration of thoracic lymph glands in the region, to identify and diagnose thoracic cancer
- The first medical institution to implement the Image Guided Radiotherapy Treatment (IGRT)
- The first medical institution to perform a virtually-augmented surgery using Google Glasses in Lebanon and the region
- First to introduce the 3D printing program in complex congenital heart disease in Lebanon and the region


OUR 2020 VISION
